They generate 40,160 jobs, including 13,000 engineering and science specialists. One in 102 people in Québec has a job related to aerospace, one of the highest ratios in the world.

In Québec, we are fortunate to have one of the most successful supply chains in the world with nearly 200 companies and total sales of \$15.5 billion. 
