



The accelerator is run through a streamlined application process followed by an 8-month operational phase





Clarifications on the process

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Who is eligible?

Any start-ups & scale-ups that are **established and registered in an EU Member State or Norway**, are encouraged to apply if they have a strong interest in the defence sector



Who selects?

The selection period will be held in **May** and managed by a selection board consisting of **European Commission members, Consortium partners, and EDA experts**



How seed voucher works?

Selected companies will receive €65,000 in seed vouchers in two instalments: 20% upon approval of the activity scorecard by the Commission, and 80% upon completion of the 8-month accelerator programme





3 defence focused themes plus an open defence call to launch the first edition of the EUDIS accelerator



Collaborative Combat & Autonomous Operations

Enhancing military-operational effectiveness and decision-making across land, air, maritime and cyberspace domains. This theme focuses on creating highly adaptive and resilient combat environments where advanced technologies enable seamless coordination between manned and unmanned systems, ensuring effective human-machine cooperation in high-intensity scenarios.

Combat Medicine & Battlefield Health Resilience

Ensuring rapid, data-driven medical support is essential to providing real-time, adaptive care in defence operations. These innovations enhance survivability, decision-making and medical readiness by integrating AI and automation ensuring faster diagnosis, optimized treatment, and improved outcomes for military personnel in high-risk situations.
